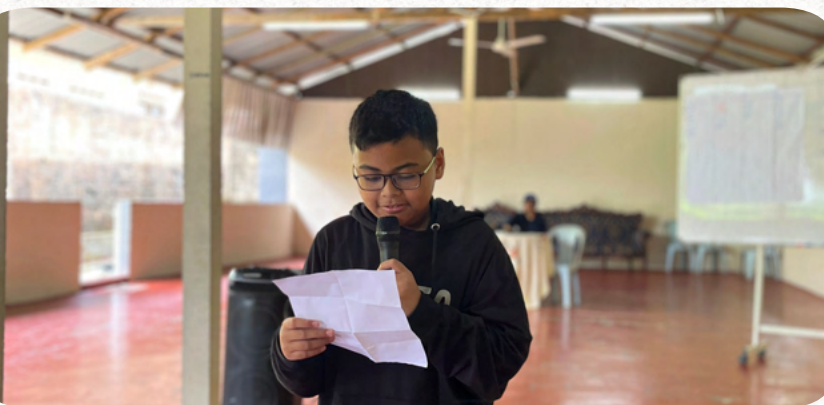
AZ-ZAHRA SCHOOL CAMPOUT 2025: EMBRACING NATURE, FRIENDSHIP & RESILIENCE!

AZS ARCHERY CLUB EDUCATIONAL TRIP TO MAGHFIRAH STABLE

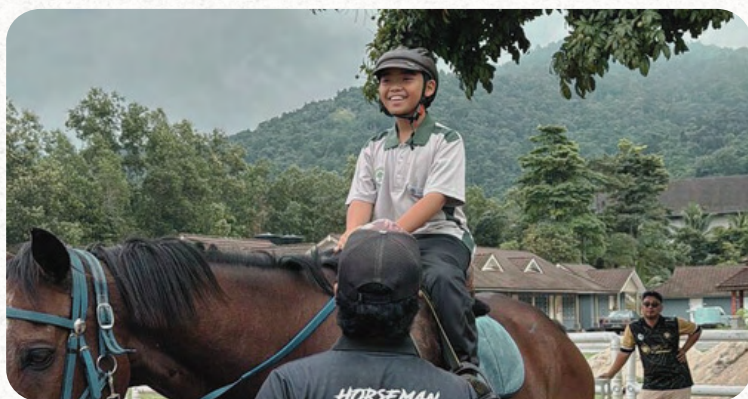

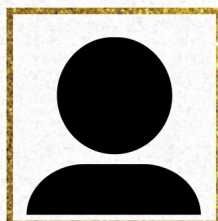

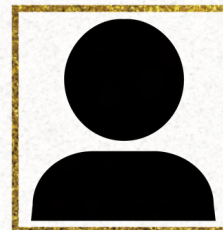
